

**IMPORTANT QUESTIONS NOT PREVIOUSLY ANSWERED IN THIS PACKET THAT I NOW
ANSWER BEFORE YOU ASK😊
(AND YOU WILL ASK😊)**

1. What happens if a player cannot make it until Sunday, can they still play?

Yes, there are no issues with their late arrival as long as they were previously on your roster and their paperwork had previously been submitted and approved.

2. Do teams bring banners or flags for Opening Ceremonies and games?

Yes, many teams do have banners flags they carry and hang during the week but it is optional.

3. Can dogs be brought to the fields?

Yes, the college allows pets as long as they are on a leash at all times and are cared for and picked up after by their owners! No pets, no matter how small, are allowed in the buildings.

4. Is there access to the fields for handicapped visitors we have traveling with our team?

We have had many handicapped people attend CBW and although it is not the easiest, it can be done. There are parking lots near the fields and their wheelchairs can be pushed or driven to the actual stands.

****Please note, no CBW workers are permitted to take any visitors, handicapped or not, on the golf carts, so please make everyone aware of this. My workers are advise of this ahead of time and will not be permitted to give anyone rides so everyone must make their own accommodations to get to the fields.**

5. Do I need to tell you if we arriving on Friday night?

Some of you who are flying in or have extremely long drives have already discussed with me arriving on the Friday evening before your tournament week begins. This is no problem, but if you have not already done so, you just need to let me know that you are coming in and approximately what time you will be arriving on campus so that I can make sure that proper people are there to check you in. Please be aware that we cannot take anyone in before 4pm that Friday and I must know ahead of time that you are coming.

6. When do our meals start and end?

IMPORTANT ONE: the meals do not begin until Saturday night's dinner so whether you arrive Friday or Saturday, you are responsible for your own meals until then so please plan your time accordingly. Also, please pay attention to this, in case you missed it on the website....the meals end on Thursday afternoon once lunch is over so there is no dinner served on Thursday evenings anymore. We found too many people left on Thursday when they were done with their games or went out to dinner with all of the families to end their week so the cafeteria will not stay open any longer. If you are staying, you will also need to plan accordingly for your dinner.

7. Does CBW supply ice to players?

Wanted to make sure all the new teams are aware of something and remind the old teams as well. CBW has a medical staff that **supplies ice for injuries only (and each injury is assessed by the CBW medical staff)**! This means, **if you plan on icing pitcher's arms after the games, you are responsible to provide your own ice packs or keep a cooler of ice for him.** There are local convenience stores in town but please be aware that we will not hand out ice packs except for injuries which are evaluated by the medical staff. Please do not come to us after a game or have the parent come to us and request an ice pack as we will decline.

8. Is there a closing ceremony and are we required to stay?

The closing ceremony is much smaller than the opening ceremony and is done right at the field for each age group where the championship game takes place. Many of the teams do stay but you are not required to stay. We will hand out all 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals as well as awards for the Saturday skill competitions winners at the closing ceremonies.
